It's More than just 'Rumors'

Comedy ushers return of live theater to Kingfisher

After squeaking in its last production just before the growing pandemic called a halt to live theater, Kingfisher Creative Inc. is coming out of quarantine this week with its latest comedic offering.

'Rumors,' Neal Simon's 1988 comedic farse about a dinner party that's gone topsy turvy, will be presented at 7 p.m. July 30 and 31 and Aug. 6 and 7 at Kingfisher Heritage School auditorium.

Co-directed by Val Snow and Tyler Mueggenborg, 'Rumors' features four couples arriving for the 10th anniversary celebration party for New York's deputy mayor and his wife, only to find the mayor wounded in bed and the wife missing.

The cast includes veterans of Kingfisher community theater, along with some newcomers: Mike Brown as Ken Gorman, Nichole Goodson as Chris Gorman, Ulanda Tiller as Claire Ganz, Kelly Kopp as Lenny Ganz, Cayman Matson as Ernie Cusack, Karisa Eaton as Cookie Cusack, Tyler Roman as Glen Cooper, Amy Duffy as Cassie Cooper, Colton Young as Officer Welch and Shane Blackwell as Officer Pudney.

The play is the eighth production for Kingfisher Creative. Its last endeavor was "Murder at the Pie Auction," presented as dinner theater in March 2020.

"We're so excited to be back with another production and grateful we're back to a place where we can safely enjoy live entertainment again," Snow said.

TV weather guy Damien Lodes to read at final Lantern event

A TV meteorologist who was born in Kingfisher will be the featured reader at the final Summer Lantern of 2021.

Damien Lodes, a meteorologist at KFOR-TV in Oklahoma City, will read to students and their families on the front lawn of Gilmour Elementary school at 7 p.m. Tuesday, July 27.

Taking It to the Streets

New law provides route for UTVs to be 'street legal'

In accordance with a new state law, certain utility vehicles can be titled, tagged and driven on city streets and state highways.

Kingfisher Tag Agency owner Eric Barker said about 10-15 of the so-called "street legal utility vehicles" have been appropriately tagged and titled through his agency since the law took effect in May.

"The vehicles must be insured and will be treated like any other motor vehicle on the road, as long as they have the required equipment and are driven in accordance with state and local traffic laws," Kingfisher Police Chief David Catron said.

To qualify as "street-legal," a utility vehicle must have either bench or side-by-side seats with safety belts or shoulder harnesses for each occupant.

The vehicle must have four wheels on the ground and a combustion engine with a piston or rotor displacement of 400 cubic centimeters or greater and be capable of maintaining speeds of at least 45 miles per hour.

To be street legal, utility vehicles also must meet the same equipment requirements as

equipment requirements as [See Street Legal, Page 2]

To qualify as a motor vehicle under the new law, the UTVs must have head, tail and brake lights, street legal tires, seat belts for all occupants and other equipment.

Volunteers sought for state study

Kingfisher Community Collaborative is recruiting volunteers to participate in a two-week, smartphone-based research study to identify how, why and in what contexts rural Oklahomers are tabases or other substances.

mans use tobacco or other substances. Sponsored by the American Cancer Society, the study is being conducted by Dr. Julia McQuoid, University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center assistant professor.

Qualified study volunteers can earn up to \$166 for their participation.

The goal of the study is to gain an understanding of rural cancer risk-related substance use behaviors by combining smartphone data collection with qualitative mapping.

Participants must be 18 or older, use at least one tobacco product at least three times per week and use at least one non-tobacco substance (alcohol, cannabis, opioid or other drug) at least three times per week.

Volunteers who don't already own a smartphone will be loaned one to use for the 14-day study period.

Prospective volunteers can visit this link: https://redcap.link/Rural-OK-OUHSC to complete a brief screening questionnaire to determine their eligibility.

Once eligible, each volunteer will download an app and complete twice-daily questionnaires that take about five to 10 minutes each.





other motor vehicles, including a windshield, functioning head and tail lights, brake lights, hazard lights, license plate lights and rear reflectors, and street-safe tires of sufficient tread.

Like other motor vehicles, street legal utility vehicles will display a license plate with a current year's registration

Drivers of vehicles tagged as street legal must be 16 years of age or older and have a valid driver's license. No special endorsement is required.

The law specifically excludes tractors and does not permit the vehicles to operate on interstate or federal high-

Catron reminds local residents that the restriction also includes U.S. 81, a federal highway, both inside and outside city limits.

The law provides an exception for crossing the highway, but during daylight hours only.

Catron said utility vehicles are not allowed to use their floodlights and must comply with city noise ordinances.

Appendicitis is the most common cause for emergency abdominal surgery in childhood, affecting 80,000 children in the United States each year, but nonoperative treatment options are viable. A new study published in JAMA found antibiotics alone successfully treated children with uncomplicated appendicitis and was associated with fewer disability days at one year.

Certain types of asthma drugs, known as B2-agonists, can boost sprint and strength performance in athletes who don't have the respiratory condition, finds a review and pooled data analysis of the available evidence, published online in The British Journal of Sports Medicine. The performance-enhancing qualities of B2agonists seem to be greater when taken by mouth rather than when inhaled, the findings indicate.





Writer claims Trump voters 'Christ crucifiers'

We read an article in Liberty magazine by a fellow named Ed Guthero who criticized all voters for President Trump as Christ crucifiers.

The article was entitled "Crucified Twice."

The gist of the column was this: No real Christian could vote for President Trump and that Trump's decision to continue to challenge how the 2020 election was handled is an attack on democracy.

The guy is obviously a victim of Trump Derangement Syndrome, possibly caused by getting his information through major news media, which have abandoned any effort to provide straight, unbiased news but, rather, have fallen into lockstep with the anti-American, pro-One World government policies of the leftist elite now in charge of the Democratic Party.

Wayne Grudgen, professor of theology and biblical studies at Phoenix Seminary, in Arizona, had a dandy response to the Guthero remarks even before Guthero got on his "high horse."

Grudgen wrote an article in a publication prior to the And Fight Correctly The 2020 election that read as follows:

Over 80% of evangelical voters supported Donald Trump not because they liked him as a person but because they favored most or all of these policies:

- originalist judges,
- pro-life policies,
- a stronger military,
- a free-market economic system,
- lower taxes,
- fewer government regulations,
- strong support for Israel,
- clearheaded recognition of the economic, military, and information threat of China
 - a high value placed on human freedom,
 - personal accountability for committing crimes,
- good jobs and school choice as the best way to help

- a strong border wall and a secure border, followed by a comprehensive reform of our immigration system,

- careful extraction and clean use of carbon-based fuels (coal, oil, natural gas),

- freedom of conscience (government should not force Christians to use their artistic skills to convey a message of approval of same-sex marriage or to use their medical skills to perform an abortion, or to use their pharmacies as the distribution point for drugs that cause abortion),

- racial inequalities in income and quality of education should primarily be solved by

- greater availability of tax-supported school choice in low-income neighborhoods,

- economic growth resulting in more and better jobs, and - an increase in safety through an increase in police presence in high crime neighborhoods

-medical marijuana should be allowed (with a prescription from a doctor) but recreational marijuana should be prohibited, and

- restrooms, locker rooms, and single-gender sports teams should be restricted to people of one biological sex or the other.

The Other Side

On the other hand, I fail to see how an evangelical Christian who believes in the moral values of the Bible could support the increasingly far-left Democratic Party. How could Christians in good conscience support a party that promotes laws and policies that:

- allow abortion up to the moment of birth, - authorize the use of our tax money to pay for abortions and gender reassignment surgery,

- cripple our economy with ever-increasing government control and taxes,

- further cripple the economy with expensive Green New Deal energy regulations,

- increase unemployment,

- weaken our military in the face of increased aggressiveness by China, promote a Jimmy Carter-like foreign policy of ap-

peasement,

abandon Israel to fend for itself,

- nullify the Senate filibuster rule (both Obama and Biden have recently spoken about this) so that all legislation can be passed with only 50 senators plus the vice president casting the tie-breaking vote,



Analysis: Why America is losing to Marxist Democrats in two sentences

If We Continue To Fight, American People Will Win And This Will Remain The Freest Country On The

Here in two sentences (really), is how the Marxist Democrats defeat us and have pushed America halfway to hell.

Thus, in dealing with the Marxist Democrats, who successfully Pearl Harbor us at every turn, we are faced with the prospect of repairing the broken. Which is much more difficult than by defense keeping things safe in the first place.

These two sentences describe why we have been losing for a long time, and now at a very rapid pace, our losses mount as the Marxists in the federal government break more things every day.

We face a flood of broken things which are important to us. Such as safe and secure borders, law and order, freedom of speech, medical freedom, the right to bear arms, a society without racism... we are losing them all.

Pretend to be weak, that he may grow arrogant. If he is taking his ease, give him no rest. If his forces are united, separate them. If sovereign and subject are in accord, put division between them. Attack him where he is unprepared, appear where you are not expected.

First steps

Theory is the foundation, then the actions based on it are the victory.

As an example of specific first steps today in repelling the onslaught against freedom by tyrannical Marxists Democrats... we have the parent revolution against school boards teaching racial hatred and division of Critical Race Theory. Dirty Harry's Garage is a fountainhead of interesting material. Harry has thumbtacked a collection of weird press clippings on a bulletin board. As an example, the story titled, "Man Hung by

Chevy" tells of a businessman who decided to check a heater hose while his car was still running. His long tie got caught in the fan belt and well...you get the picture. The lesson Dirty Harry wants to impart with his bulletin board is that you should never work on your own vehicle and if you do insist on playing amateur mechanic wear a bow tie

or turn off the engine first!

Another clipping on DirtyHarry'sbulletinboard came from the Kalamazoo Gazette. The yellowed and oil stained clipping dated 1995 told of an intellectual giant of a man named James Burn. According to the author James owned a "farm truck," the implication being that anyone who owns such a vehicle is not running on all cylinders. It seems that James was bothered by a loud noise, even when his wife was not in the truck. So, the 34 year old resident of Alamo, Michigan, convinced a "friend" to drive his truck while James hung underneath to ascertain where the noise was originating. Of course, James never heard the noise ever again.

You have a right to be transgender; You don't have a right to expose yourself to women.

How many examples could one give to show what a sick world leftwing activists, the media and the Democrats - the left's political party - have wrought? The number is equal to the number of policies they advocate.

There is no more obvious example than their position on the display of genitalia in front of girls and women.

No issue - with the possible exceptions of defunding police departments as murders increase and biological men competing in women's sports - better reveals the moral and rational decline of an individual or institution. If anyone you care about defends a person's right to display their genitalia in front of a group of girls and women, my heart goes out to you. It is very painful to lose respect for a loved one.

Within the lifetime of even the youngest person reading this column, exposing the male organ to strangers, especially women and girls, was considered sick and criminal. Men who did it were arrested and charged with indecent exposure, and rightly so. In the span of a few years, thanks to the schools people still send their children to, and thanks to the media people still watch, listen to and read, exposing one's genitalia is to be considered wholesome and not only legal but a fundamental civil right.

A couple of weeks ago at a spa in Los Angeles, a biological man walked into a women's changing area completely naked. 

Paul and Fauci go at each other again at Senate hearing on COVID-19

Another heated exchange between Sen. Rand Paul and Dr. Anthony Fauci stole the show Tuesday at a Senate hearing on COVID-19, although participants also raised other key points.

Fauci, director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases, clashed publicly with the Kentucky Republican for at least the third time in recent months.

"Sen. Paul, you do not know what you are talking about, quite frankly, and I want to say that officially," Fauci said at one point, raising

Other public health officials in the Biden administration also took questions about topics such as the delta variant of COVID-19, the origins of the virus, and the potential need for vaccine booster shots. And one Donald Trump foe credited the 45th president for the availability of three vaccines.

Fauci, in his post since 1984, became a familiar face of the Trump administration's efforts to slow COVID-19 and President Joe Biden made him his principal adviser on the issue.

Joining Fauci on a panel testifying before the Senate Health, Education, Labor and Pensions Committee were Dr. Rochelle Walensky, director of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention; Dr. Janet Woodcock, acting commissioner of the Food and Drug Administration; and Dawn O'Connell, assistant secretary for preparedness and response at the Department of Health and Human Services.

'Dr. Fauci, knowing that it is a crime to lie to Congress, do you wish to retract your statement from May 11 when you claimed that the NIH |National Institutes of Health never funded gain of function research in Wuhan?" Paul, who is a physician, asked.

Fauci responded: "Sen. Paul, I have never lied before the Congress, and I do not retract that statement.'

In May, Fauci said the United States never funded the Wuhan Institute of Virology's gain of function projects. But new information emerging since that testimony shows that Fauci's National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases did fund research that involved making a virus more transmissible from an animal to a human.

The term "gain of function" describes a risky process of making a disease more dangerous or contagious for the purpose of studying a response.

As previously reported by The Daily Signal, the U.S. government from 2014 to 2019 gave almost \$600,000 to the nonprofit EcoHealth Alliance, which in turn used the money to pay for coronavirus research at the Wuhan lab.

The National Institutes of Health, parent agency to Fauci's institute, sent a letter to EcoHealth Alliance in July 2020, asking about its relationship with the Wuhan Institute of Virology. NIH also suspended the nonprofit's grant, pending answers to several questions.

Specifically, NIH asked EcoĤealth Alliance to explain the disappearance of a scientist who worked at the Wuhan lab, and to allow a U.S. government-led inspection of the lab.

On Monday, a reporter asked White House press secretary Jen Psaki whether Biden would ask Trump to advocate publicly for Americans to get vaccinated against COVID-19. Psaki said there was no interest in that.

4. 'Lose the Trust' on **Booster Shot**

Fauci told senators that the federal government is "doing studies to determine whether or not we will need boosters' to extend the effectiveness of the vaccine.

"We don't want people to believe that when you are talking about boosters, that means the vaccines are not effective," Fauci told the committee. "They are highly effective. We are talking about the durability of that.'

However, the Israeli Ministry of Health last week informed some health agencies that they could start administering a third dose of the Pfizer with a compromised immune system or other specific con-

The Jerusalem Post reported that this could include those with rheumatological or autoimmune diseases: those with hematologic malignancies or with cancer; and certain transplant recipients.

Committee Chairwoman Patty Murray, D-Wash., asked: "How will the administration determine if booster shots are needed?"

Fauci and others responded that research is ongoing.

This was bothersome to Sen. Richard Burr, R-N.C., who said the response from officials about a booster shot indicated "we haven't learned anything."

The committee's ranking member, Burr noted mistakes and delayed response from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and other public health agencies in 2020 as COVID-19 spread.

"To say we are going to make this decision based on research we've got going on in CDC based on the information we've put out and only our research counts, to basically ignore the Israeli data or the Pfizer data—I'm not suggesting we are entirely doing that," Burr said, cutting himself off.

"My question would be: Has Israel given us transparency into their data?" Burr asked. "I realize we want accuracy, but do we really have to wait for CDC to complete the data? Do you think you are going to come to a different conclusion than Israel did?'

Walinsky, head of the CDC, said the United States has worked with researchers from Israel and other coun-

We've already had two conversations with Israel. We have data sharing from our cohorts as well as from theirs. We also have been in discussions with the U.K. to see what data they have, because they are several weeks ahead of us on the delta variant. We intend to leverage all of the data we have around the world to share liberally with other countries in the hopes they will share with us, so that we can make the proper decisions here and around the world.
